Akimat of Kyzylorda oblast, Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University on November 27, 2020 organize an on-line international scientific-practical conference on the occasion of the 130th anniversary of Mustafa Shokai, one of the leaders of the Alash movement, who fought for the freedom of the whole Turkic people. The theme of the conference is **“Mustafa Shokai is the leader of the movement for freedom and unity of the Turkic people”**.

The purpose of the conference is to analyze the experience and views of Mustafa Shokai in the struggle for the independence of a single Turkestan, promote the heritage of a public and political figure, determine the meaning and content of the idea of independence in modern Kazakhstan, develop concepts on a new political methodological basis.

**Objectives of the conference:**

- attracting the attention of domestic and foreign social scientists, young scientists, teachers, doctoral students and master students to the study of the history of the political struggle carried out by the leaders of the Alash movement and M. Shokai on the way to independence;

Requirements for the article:

- Availability of UDC index
- article volume 6-7 pages , **Font:** Times New Roman, KZ Times New Roman (size - 14 pt, line spacing - 1, Margins: Left - 3 cm, Right - 2 cm, Top - 2.5 cm, Bottom - 2.5 cm, indentation on the new line - 1 cm);

On the first line, the title of the report is written in capital letters ( in bold), the author's last name, first name , patronymic, institution, city, country are given at the bottom, and the text of the article is given in one line.

- Formulas must be executed in the text of the Microsoft Equation Formula Editor and images (black and white), JPEG, JPG must be scanned in a format of at least 300 dpi.

- References are listed in full in the article (in square brackets) at the end of the article. If you use a link, you must specify the source page. For example: [1, p. 12].

Conference proceedings will be published in the form of an electronic collection. Late or non-compliant materials will not be included. The author is responsible for the content of the article, grammatical and stylistic writing and editing in accordance with the requirements. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject articles submitted to the conference that do not meet the theme and requirements of the conference.
